



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT TOWARDS SQUAD

As a member of the squad, I fully understand and agree to the following conditions:

1. I will be punctual at all times for training and competition.
2. I will work hard to make the squad successful.
3. I will support and respect fellow squad members at all times.
4. I am fully aware that I may have to share my position and in some cases play fewer quarters than other squad members.
5. I will at all times respect any decisions made by my coach. I understand that squad selections are made to win games and not glorify individuals.
6. I will at all times respect any decisions made by officials and show respect towards them.
7. I will put my Club first before School matches, in the event of a clash.
8. I will put my Club first for Regional games before School or County games in the event of a clash.
9. I understand that the club's **THREE STRIKE RULE** (see Training Code of Conduct) applies whilst playing and training with the squad.

MATCH DAY CONDUCT

It is important that all players understand what is expected from them at matches:

1. Arrive at the stated time for warm up and pre-match team talk;
2. Club netball dress to be worn at all games;
3. Ensure nails are short, hair tied up, no jewellery or piercings to be worn;
4. Water bottles to be placed in the water carrier;
5. Coach, Team Manager and subs to station themselves with water carrier and kit bag away from parents, carers and supporters;
6. Warm up together as a unit;
7. Players to stay with Coach during quarter breaks;
8. For the quarter team talks, players to line up in position order GK-GD-WD-C-WA-GA-GS and to stay focused, listening to the Coach;
9. Captain to shout 3 cheers at the end of the game;
10. Shake hands with all of the opposition saying 'well played';
11. Thank the umpires;
12. Gather as a team at the end of each game for debrief;
