



Wilmslow Lightning Netball Club: COVID 19- Guidance for Coaches

Scope:

This document explains:

- 1) The processes to be implemented to support identification of close contacts in the event a member is diagnosed COVID 19 Positive within 48 hours of a WLNC event, (see WLNC CoVDoc-9 for process and definition of close contacts)

Role of the Coaches:

- 1) Work with the Team Manager to ensure Health Declarations are completed
- 2) Remind all attendees of matches and training sessions to follow the procedures, including reminders about social distancing
- 3) Implement England Netball COVID 19 guidelines for stage 4a/b
- 4) Keep a record of all sub-teams for drills at each Training to Win session
- 5) For matches, minimise numbers involved (Maximum of 9 players) and minimise number of changeovers between zones. Keep a record of all changes.
- 6) In the event of a COVID 19 positive diagnosis, contact the COVID Officer IMMEDIATELY to provide details of close contacts. Agree who will contact opposition team if appropriate.
- 7) Note: If you have observed a breach of social distancing within the session add the additional names to the close contacts rather than restricted to those defined in WLNC CoVDoc-9 document
- 8) The Coach can choose to move any training session to stage 2 if they deem this appropriate considering their own circumstances or that of the group.
